After six years, John decided to stop selling paintings to Drewe. He didn't like the man, and he had enough money. But it was too late. The police knew about Drewe. They soon came to John's house. Then he learned from the police about what Drewe was doing with his paintings. He had removed John's name from them, and he sold them as paintings by famous artists. Everyone thought they were real. They paid a lot of money for them.

They were John's paintings, so John had to go to jail for four months. When he came out, he was famous, too. The newspapers wrote about him. People wanted to know his painting techniques.

After that, he worked with the police to find copies of famous art. He kept painting and had a big show in London of his paintings. They were copies of famous paintings. Now, of course, they had his name on them. But he sold them all for a lot of money.

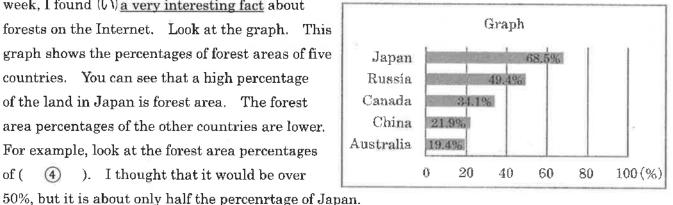
